1	AN ACT relating to occupational licensure for military service members and
2	veterans.
3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	SECTION <u>14.</u> A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 12 IS CREATED TO
5	READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) As used in this section, "administrative body" has the same meaning as in KRS
7	<u>12.010.</u>
8	(2) Each administrative body that issues a license, permit, or certificate, or other
9	document that is required to operate within any business, profession, or
10	occupation in the Commonwealth may issue a license, certificate, or other
11	document to a United States military service member or veteran who is seeking a
12	license, permit, certificate, or other document under this section and has:
13	(a) Separated from the military with an honorable discharge, discharge under
14	honorable conditions, or a general discharge under honorable conditions
15	within two (2) years preceding the date of applying for the license, permit,
16	certificate, or other document;
17	(b) Received training, education, or experience during active, National Guard,
18	or federal reserve military service to the extent that such training,
19	education, or experience satisfies the requirements established by law and
20	administrative regulations of the respective board for the issuance of any
21	license, permit, certificate, or other document, however styled or
22	denominated, required for the practice of any business, profession, or
23	occupation in the Commonwealth; and
24	(c) Submitted his or her DD 214 form or other proof of satisfactory completion
25	of military training to the administrative body as part of the license or
26	certificate application.
27	(3) (a) Nothing isin subsection (2) of this section shall require an administrative

1		body to issue a license, permit or other document if the administrative body
2		determines that the military training or experience does not meet the
3		requirements established by the administrative for issueance of a license,
4		permit, certificate, or other document to operate within a business,
5		profession, or occupation in the Commonwealth.

7	<u>(4)</u>	Administrative bodies that receive multiple requests under this section are
8		directed to publish clear guidelines to clarify requirements. These guidelines may
9		be published electronically, in pring, or by the promulgation of administrative
10		regulations Each administrative body that issues a license, permit, certificate, or
11		other document that is required to operate within a business, profession, or
12		occupation in the Commonwealth shall promulgate administrative regulations to
13		carry out this section.
14	<u>(5)</u>	Military training and experience submitted under subsection (2) of this section
15		<u>shall not be used as a substitute or in lieu of:</u>
16		(a) A postsecondary school degree when a degree is a prerequisite for a license,
17		permit, certification, or other document; or
18		(b) A specified examination when passage of an examination is a prerequisite
19		for a license, permit, certificate, or other document.
