SB97

ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to the Alabama National Guard and members of the national guard of other states; to amend Section 31-12-2 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for certain rights when called to active duty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 31-12-2 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§31-12-2.

"(a) Whenever any active member of the Alabama National Guard, or a member of the national guard of another state who is employed in this state, in time of war, armed conflict, or emergency proclaimed by the Governor or by the President of the United States, shall be called or ordered to state active duty ~~for a period of 30 consecutive days or more~~ or federally funded duty for other than training, the provisions of the ~~SSCRA~~ federal Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (SCRA) and the federal Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act shall apply."^u

"(b) Those active members as defined in subsection (a) called or ordered to active duty for a period of 30 consecutive days or more shall be eligible for military

1 differential pay pursuant to Section 31-12-5 and restoration
2 of annual or sick leave pursuant to Section 31-12-8."

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
4 first day of the third month following its passage and
5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
