39 Section 1. Section **53B-16-107** is enacted to read:

- 42 (1) As used in this section, "credit" includes proof of equivalent noncredit course
- 43 <u>completion awarded by the Utah College of Applied Technology.</u>
- 44 (2) An institution of higher education listed in Section 53B-2-101 shall award credit for

45 military service and training as recommended by a postsecondary accreditation agency or

46 association designated by the State Board of Regents or the Utah College of Applied
